Complications and patient disappointment or dissatisfaction with results are a statistical reality in every surgeon's practice. Although we strive to reduce the number of these issues in numerous ways, a small number of patients may experience a complication or a disappointing result.

_____ Ultimately the fee paid for any procedure is for the performance of a procedure and not for a guaranteed result or for a guarantee of satisfaction.

_____ The healing process is unique for every patient and final healing can take as long as 12-18 months. Depending upon the type of procedure and the unique healing characteristics of each patient.

_____ For revisions requested and performed within one year of your original surgery the following fees are the patients responsibility:

- _____ Anesthesia Fees
- _____ Surgeons Fees

_____ After one year all adjustments to your original procedure will be considered a new procedure.

The following situations are not considered revisions .

_____ Breast Lift - Relaxation of Skin and further dropping of the breast.

_____ Breast Augmentation - Capsular contracture with implant firmness or distortion. Desire for change in volume.

_____ Liposuction - Weight gain after liposuction. Desire for more fat removal from liposuctioned areas or new area.

_____ Face/ Neck / Brow Lift - Retightening of the skin.
